## Worcester Students' Union Elections - A step by step guide to nominating yourself as a candidate via <u>www.worcsu.com/yourvoice/elections/</u>

This guide will show you exactly how to stand as a candidate in SU Elections.

Nominations are **online only** and will require you to log in to the Worcester Students' Union website. If you have any issues logging in to the website, please contact the Students' Union Marketing Team via at <u>c.servini@worc.ac.uk</u> or 01905 543225.

## Please note you cannot nominate yourself until nominations open on 20/01/2025.


The process is straightforward but there are a few elements we need to make candidates fully aware of.

 First log in to SU website at <u>www.worcsu.com/login/</u> Once logged in go to <u>www.worcsu.com/yourvoice/elections/</u>, and click on the Nominate Yourself Here Button on the top of the page.


4) You will then be presented with the option to choose which position you wish to stand for.



6) You will then be asked to confirm your nomination.

- 7) You should then return to the stand in election page. Scroll down until you find the details of the position you are standing for again
- 8) **Submit your manifesto.** Students **must** submit a manifesto to be candidates in the election. A manifesto states what you will undertake to do in your year in office should you be elected.



document or upload it as a pdf/picture. Please note that if you upload over 250 words your manifesto will be cut off at the 250-word limit without any editing, so it might be in the middle of a sentence.

12) Graphically designed manifestos are excellent at grabbing voters' attention. If you want to upload one of these please send it to

<u>SUElections@worc.ac.uk before the</u> <u>deadline. You will still need to upload a</u> <u>text copy yourself!</u>

13) When you are totally happy with your manifesto click **"save".** Make sure you have re-read it in case of spelling mistakes. This is especially important if you are sending us a graphically designed manifesto as it is more difficult to change.

Once you have stood and uploaded the manifestos of the role(s) you are standing for the nominations process online will be complete.

Nominations close at 12 noon on Monday 17th February
